You may apply for a scholarship for any upcoming in person EASL CLE by submitting your resume and a letter detailing your interest in practicing entertainment, arts, and/or sports law to the Program Chair of the CLE for which you are applying.

Details

- The scholarship covers CLE admission fee only. Travel, lodging, and other expenses are not covered.
- Students must be enrolled in, and in good standing at, an ABA accredited law school at the time the student applies for the scholarship.
- Applications must be received no less than three (3) weeks before the CLE for which the student is applying.
- The scholarship is non-transferrable and no substitutions will be permitted.
- A maximum of one (1) scholarship per CLE will be given.
