The Mechanical Licensing Collective A Legal Perspective

The Music Modernization Act (MMA) significantly changed the copyright law with respect to compulsory mechanical licensing of musical works for digital uses. It created a new blanket license and a mechanical licensing collective to administer the license and collect and distribute royalties.

The Mechanical Licensing Collective (The MLC) began operating in earnest in 2020, and the blanket license became available on January 1, 2021.
